The youth will be leaving for their Mexico Mission Trip on July 1st Please keep them in your prayers as they travel. The following is a brief history of the family they will be building a home with:



Sixto and Lorenza have been married for more than sixteen years. Sixto and his daughter Anay, who is sixteen years old, both work in the fields when there are jobs available, earning a average of \$60 to \$70/week each. The three younger children, Ismael (14 years old), Oswaldo (12 years old), and Esther (9 years old) attend school with the help of a government program. Live Different first came into contact with this family because of a medical emergency. Anay suffered a respiratory infection caused in part by the poor living conditions of the family's home. They had been staying in a borrowed home nearby, but when the owners of the home returned, they had to move to an empty plot of land that they owned. As they have not yet had the time or funds to build a proper house their land, they have been living in a home made of plastic and other scrap materials for the last three months. This is a very bad situation for Anay's health condition, and if nothing is changed, the health of the entire family will be at risk. Life for this family has not been easy, but they are determined to have a better future and are excited at the opportunity to have a new home where their children can grow up to be healthy and safe.
