Good News! We have now hired our Director of Music Ministry for St Peter's Church. *Mary Martell* will officially join us at the beginning of April.

"Mary Martell is a teacher, pianist, organist and conductor. She received her Master Degree in Piano Performance from the University of Calgary where she studied with Charles Foreman, Willard Schultz, Donald Bell and Talmon Hertz and participated in intensive Master Classes with various performers including Christopher Hogwood and Martin Isepp. She studied choral conducting with Ed Pounds, George Evelyn, Carleton Elliott and Sir David Willcocks. From 1988 -1990 she was the Choir Director at Universite Canadienne en France, in Nice, France. With her family, Mary moved to Chicago in 1991. While there she served as Music Director in several large faith communities including the historic, Chicago Sinai Congregation. She was a founding faculty member at the Chicago High School for the Performing Arts, and Choral Director at Columbia College, Merit School of Music and Bridges Partners in Music. Returning to Canada Mary was on staff at Dalhousie University for two years when she decided to return to the city she always felt was home, Calgary."
