Let there be Light: The total budget for the stained glass window, including installation is about \$40,000. Thanks to the generosity of St. Peter's, we have just over 75% of this funding currently in hand. In order to get the go ahead from the Diocese, we need to have all the funding identified. We are seeking \$9,000 more to complete the project. This includes a contingency, which, if not spent, will be returned to the Capital Replacement Fund, which is providing \$5,000 for this project.
